HOUSTON HOUSING AUTHORITY TAKES ACTION FOLLOWING MAYORAL DECISION ON '2640 FOUNTAIN VIEW' PROJECT; ISSUES REQUEST FOR INFORMATION ON AVAILABLE PROPERTIES

HOUSTON – In response to [the decision by the City of Houston Mayor Sylvester Turner to seek alternatives to the proposed 2640 Fountain View Road project](#), the Houston Housing Authority (HHA) is issuing a Request for Information (RFI) to the general public seeking details on available properties suitable for the development of a multifamily housing community. Given the August 1 media release by the City of Houston noting Mayor Sylvester Turner's desire for an alternative location for this project within City Council District G, the HHA is aggressively evaluating any and all offers for land available in aforementioned district.

The HHA is asking that all interested firms, brokers, developers, direct sellers, government entities, and commercial businesses send letters of interest along with the corresponding Development Site Assessment Form to the agency with attention to the HHA's Procurement Director, Kevin Coleman. Submissions are to be drafted on company letterhead, dated, and include a handwritten signature.
