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The Houston Housing Authority ("HHA"), has issued Amendment No. 2 to RFP 21-39 Choice Neighborhood People Plan Consultant to answer the following questions that were received on time:

Question 1: What is the anticipated date that the work should commence?

Answer 1: As soon as possible post award. September 1st.

Question 2: Should the budget include the costs of the first year along with the cost of each annual renewal, if the renewal years are anticipated to have different costs?

Answer 2: This is negotiable.

Question 3: Will HHA want the contractor to continue to do work after the completion of the overall transformation plan and its submission to HUD?

Answer 3: That is not currently anticipated.

Question 4: Are payments of "stipends" to residents to enhance their participation in the survey process, community meetings, and focus groups an allowable expense?

Answer 4: This is negotiable.

Question 5: If payment of stipends to residents is an allowable expense, is it possible to structure the payment of the stipends in such a way that they will not impact the calculation of residents' rent obligations to HHA?

Answer 5: Good question. We will research.

All other terms and conditions shall remain the same.
