### Houston Housing Authority & City Council Member Announce \$150,000 to Renovate Hike & Bike Trail

(Houston, TX) - The Houston Housing Authority's National Night Out Block Party at Cuney Homes in Historic Third Ward will be unlike any other in the city because this year, a \$150,000 donation will be made to support safety and sustainability for the Columbia Tap Trail renovation project.

District D Council Member Dr. Carolyn Evans-Shabazz, HHA President & CEO David A. Northern, Sr., and Houston Chief of Police Troy Finner will join attendees for a night of community building. The block party will serve an equally important purpose of investing in improving a historic part of the Third Ward.

The Columbia Tap Trail is a four-mile hike and bike trail that runs through Third Ward. Decades of wear-andtear have caused the section of the trail that meets HHA's Cuney Homes to become a dangerous eye sore. HHA committed to joining forces with District D and Harris County to uplift the Columbia Tap Trail with long-term improvements.

## "District D is pleased to support our friends in the Cuney Homes community on National Night Out. Our \$100,000 funding commitment will increase safety and security for all citizens to enjoy the Columbia Tap Trail," says Council Member Evans - Shabazz.

HHA is contributing \$50,000 to create an official gateway to welcome people to Cuney Homes and the trailhead and to install lighting, benches, an emergency call box, public art, and a new entryway sign featuring the historical significance of the site.

HHA's National Night Out starts at 4:00 pm on Tuesday, October 4, 2022, at the Cuney Homes Basketball Court (3260 Truxillo Street, Houston, TX 77004). 400 meals will be provided to kick off the event. A **press conference will be held at 5:00 pm**, where Council Member Evans-Shabazz and President Northern will announce the donations. The festivities will continue from 5:30 - 7:30 pm with a block party, more food, music, line dancing, and fun for the whole family.

National Night Out at Cuney Homes is sponsored in part by the Third Ward – Cuney Homes Choice Neighborhood Initiative. In partnership with the City of Houston, this two-year resident-led planning process reimagines a new Cuney Homes and Third Ward by bringing people together to create a shared vision that supports the revitalization of the entire Third Ward community.
