The Houston Housing Authority (HHA), has issued this Amendment No. 1 to RFP 23 – 55 Property Management at APV Properties for the purposes of:

- 1. Answering the following Questions submitted to HHA in writing by the specified due date:
 - **Question 1:** Does the management company provide comments on the property management agreement, specifically indemnity and insurance, when we submit the RFP or after?
 - **Answer 1:** Bidders are allowed to provide redlined comments to the property management agreement when submitting the proposal for this RFP.
 - **Question 2:** Once the contracts are awarded, when does HHA anticipate the management companies will begin management of the properties?
 - **Answer 2:** This information will be provided and discussed with the selected vendor/firm/company/contractor.
 - **Question 3:** See Section 7.3.7.2 Can you clarify what documentation is needed?
 - a. Provide, within the five (5) business references, a status statement of compliance to the provided five (5) business references for the required, proposed delivery or performance schedule.
 - **Answer 3:** Bidders are to provide a list of five (5) business references related to the purpose of this solicitation that will be verified by HHA. The bidder should provide from each reference listed, a statement of compliance to your company's ability to adhere to delivery and scheduling requirements.
 - **Question 4:** See Section 7.3.6 Property Management Fees
 - a. HUD usually requires a per-door management fee for federally subsidized properties, and there is no indication of that in this RFP. Should the proposed fees be quoted per door or as a percentage?
 - **Answer 4:** The proposed fees are to quoted 'per door' and not 'per percentage'.

Question 5 How many properties does this consist of?

Answer 5: There are seven (7) properties for this solicitation: Fulton Village, Heatherbrook Apartments, Independence Heights, Lincoln Park, Oxford, Cuney and Ewing. Cuney and Ewing will be counted as one.

All other terms and conditions shall remain the same.
